

## I ROTARY CHARITY TOURNAMENT RAMBLAS TENERIFE



Amarilla Golf members and the players from all of the islands other courses showed their generosity and willingness for charity by participating in the **first Rotary Club Tenerife Rambla**. The chosen venue was Amarilla Golf.
